



IMPORTANT UPDATE

Change to FOI Application Fee in Victoria

Please note that from 1 July 2010 the application fee for a request for access to documents under section 17 of the *Freedom of Information Act 1982 (Vic)* (“FOI Act”) will be \$23.90

The Victorian Government Gazette (No. G10) dated 11 March 2010 contained a notice from the Treasurer advising that the value of one fee unit under the *Monetary Units Act 2004* will, from 1 July 2010, be \$11.95.¹

The FOI Act states that an application fee will be two fee units. Therefore, the application fee under the FOI Act will be \$23.90. Note that the Monetary Units Act permits rounding to the nearest 10 cents² (which will not be required this year) and that the new fee applies from **1 July 2010**. Therefore, you should amend any forms, literature, web sites or other information generated by your agency to reflect that change with effect from 1 July 2010.

Finally, just another timely reminder that GST is NOT payable on any application fees or access charges under the FOI Act.
